Outstanding Educator Award

The **Outstanding Educator Award** is presented by the ABAC Alumni Association and recognizes professionals who have demonstrated leadership and innovation in and outside of the classroom that facilitate lifelong learning. This award seeks to recognize individuals in education including, but not limited to, elementary, secondary, and post-secondary education teachers or administrators who have made exceptional contributions to education. Active and retired educators are eligible for this award. This award was established in 1995.

Eligibility and Criteria

- The Outstanding Educator Award is open to alumni who have attended Abraham Baldwin Agricultural College and have distinguished themselves through professional achievement, community service, and service to the college.
- 2. Those nominated are not required to have received a degree or certificate from ABAC nor are they required to have majored in education.
- 3. Nominations will be accepted using our online form from July 1 August 15 each year. Nominees will be considered for two consecutive years. Individuals may be re-nominated after two years.
- 4. Nominees will be contacted and provided with an application to be submitted by September 30. In addition to the standard application, up to three supporting documents are welcomed but not required. Examples include articles or letters of recommendation.
- 5. Selection for the award will be made by the ABAC Alumni Association Awards Committee, and the committee may consider nominees for a different award than the one for which they were originally nominated.
- 6. Recipients will be notified in advance and awards will be presented during the annual Alumni Awards Program during Homecoming in April.
