Outstanding Healthcare Professional

The Outstanding Healthcare Professional Award is presented by the ABAC Alumni Association in recognition of those who have made a significant impact in the community through leadership, community service, dedication to their field, and service to the College. This award is designed to recognize individuals in the various areas of healthcare, including but not limited to medicine, nursing, dentistry, pharmacy, mental health professionals, or health care administration. This award was established in 1995.

Eligibility and Criteria

- 1. The **Outstanding Healthcare Professional Award** is open to alumni who have attended Abraham Baldwin Agricultural College and have distinguished themselves through professional achievement, community service, and service to the college.
- 2. Those nominated are not required to have received a degree or certificate from ABAC nor are they required to have majored in a healthcare related field.
- 3. Nominations will be accepted using our online form from July 1 August 15 each year. Nominees will be considered for two consecutive years. Individuals may be re-nominated after two years.
- 4. Nominees will be contacted and provided with an application to be submitted by September 30. In addition to the standard application, up to three supporting documents are welcomed but not required. Examples include articles or letters of recommendation.
- 5. Selection for the award will be made by the ABAC Alumni Association Awards Committee, and the committee may consider nominees for a different award than the one for which they were originally nominated.
- 6. Recipients will be notified in advance and awards will be presented during the annual Alumni Awards Program during Homecoming in April.
