Outstanding Young Alumnus Award

The ABAC Outstanding Young Alumnus Award is presented by the ABAC Alumni Association in recognition of alumni ages 40 and below who have distinguished themselves through professional achievement, community service and service to the College. This award was established in 1981 in honor of Helen Strickland.

Eligibility and Criteria

- 1. The **Outstanding Young Alumnus Award** is open to alumni who attended ABAC and have distinguished themselves at a young age. Recipients shall not be older than 40 on April 1 of the year the award is presented to them.
- 2. Those nominated are not required to have received a degree or certificate from ABAC.
- 3. Nominations will be accepted using our online form from July 1 August 15 each year. Nominees will be considered for two consecutive years. Individuals may be re-nominated after two years.
- 4. Nominees will be contacted and provided with an application to be submitted by September 30. In addition to the standard application, up to three supporting documents are welcomed but not required. Examples include articles or letters of recommendation.
- 5. Selection for the award will be made by the ABAC Alumni Association Awards Committee, and the committee may consider nominees for a different award than the one for which they were originally nominated.
- 6. Recipients will be notified in advance and awards will be presented during the annual Alumni Awards Program during Homecoming in April.
